

Setting up a Wikispaces Website (wiki)

Option One – If you don't already have a Wikispaces account.

1. If you go to Google and search for 'wikispaces' and 'teacher', the top search result will take you into the advertising free sign up area for teachers. Fill in the form on that page. Alternatively, you could just click on this link ☺

Generally, you would only need to have a 'Protected' site so that you control who edits pages but anyone can view. You could set it to private if you have security issues but then you would need to invite people by email so that they could view the page.

2. When you click 'Join', you will be taken to your new wiki page to begin editing. You will also then be a member of Wikispaces.

Option Two – If you are a member of Wikispaces but don't have a website

1. Go to <http://wikispaces.com> and click on 'Sign in' in the top right hand corner (it's quite small).
2. Enter the username and password you chose when you joined Wikispaces previously and click 'Sign In'.
3. You will be taken to an information page with the latest information from the wikispaces team and you will see your username at the top right which means you are signed in.
4. You can choose to make a new space on this page BUT it won't be an ad free teacher wiki. To get an ad free space, go to <http://www.wikispaces.com/site/for/teachers> You will stay logged in when you go to this link.
5. Now you can fill in the form to get a teacher space under your login.
6. When you click 'Create' you will be taken to your new wiki to start editing.
